- **Novo Nordisk's** obesity management treatment *Saxenda* (liraglutide) has been recommended for use by NICE.

- **Bristol Myers Squibb's** *Opdivo* (nivolumab) plus *Yervoy* (ipilimumab) has received approval from the European Commission for the first-line treatment of adult patients with metastatic non-small cell lung cancer.
